

Triangle Establishes Partnership with Passaic County Technical Institute (Wayne, New Jersey)

In 2009, Triangle began a partnership with Passaic County Technical Institute (PCTI). The focus of the partnership has been with their Manufacturing Technology and Engineering Programs. Triangle recognizes the diminishing labor pool in the manufacturing industry and the growing demand for talent in this field, thus raising students' awareness of the cutting edge technology and the variety of career opportunities available to them.

Notable Highlights:

- Over the course of the last two years, Triangle has organized plant tours and engineering/CNC Machine programming software demonstrations, linking education to the real world environment.
- John Morin (Manufacturing Trainer) and Tom Heckman (Manufacturing Engineer) have both joined the school's Advisory Board, providing technical expertise on a current initiative to revise the Manufacturing Technology program curriculum.
- Triangle hired a senior from the Manufacturing Technology program to complete a cooperative education assignment. The co-op is a combination of hands on training and ongoing projects in the assembly and laser marking functions.
